Notice is hereby given that the City of Bothell will receive sealed Bids for the following construction project. Bids will be received in the Lytle House at the Park of Bothell Landing, located at 9929 NE 180th Street, (425) 486-7430, in the City of Bothell, Washington up to the hour of **2:30 p.m. (PST)**, as **determined by the designated Bid clock at said location, on Tuesday, March 6, 2012**, at which time all Bids will be publicly opened and read to determine the apparent lowest Bidder.

The **BOTHELL CROSSROADS PROJECT PHASE III** proposes to shift the alignment of State Route (SR) 522 south of its existing alignment at Bothell Landing. The general aspects of this Work will involve construction of the new roadway including utilities, grading, hazardous soil remediation, retaining walls, lighting, traffic control elements, landscaping, wetland mitigation and erosion control as described in this Proposal. The project is also a GreenRoads™ Pilot Project that will require documentation and assistance by the Contractor. The total estimated cost for this project is in the range of \$17,750,000 - \$18,750,000. Prevailing wage requirements are in effect.

Construction Plans, Specifications and Contract Documents may be inspected at the office of the Public Works Department Dawson Building. A Pre-Bid meeting and site visit will also be held at 2:30 p.m. on Tuesday, February 21, 2012 at the address above. Bidders are strongly urged to attend. The Contract Project Engineer is Ryan Roberts at (425) 806-6823. A Bidder Inquiry Form is included with the Instructions to Bidders and must be used for any questions regarding the Bid documents.

Free-of-charge access to project bid documents (Plans, Specifications without appendices, addenda, and Bidders List) is provided to Prime Bidders, Subcontractors, and Vendors by going to www.bxwa.com and clicking on "Posted Projects", "Public Works", and "City of Bothell". It is recommended that Bidders "Register" in order to receive automatic e-mail notification of future addenda and to place themselves on the "Self-Registered Bidders List". Bidders that do not register will not be automatically notified of addenda and will need to periodically check the on-line plan room for addenda issued on this project.
